News Alert: Hong Kong Airport

To our Valued Customers,



Hundreds of protesters have congregated at the airport terminal building in Hong Kong staging a rally for the second consecutive day. Because of the demonstrations, the Hong Kong Airport - one of the world's busiest - has been closed for passenger traffic: 160 departing flights along with 150 arrivals have been cancelled to date. However, we anticipate that this closure will not cause any significant delay to our Hellmann Air Freight operations. Due to the cancellations of passenger flights, cargo flights are able to utilize all runways and slot times, therefore allowing a smooth flow for customer cargo on freighter service, which represents 99% of our current long haul cargo movements. At this time, 100% of

cargo booked on today's flights has been delivered to the airport without interruption. We will continue to monitor the situation and share updates when necessary.
